ABSTRACT

Xu Qian's book on water services disputes analyses what is a growing area in international dispute resolution—yet an area that is fragmented across different legal regimes. Qian's book provides a useful resource to examine the issues involved in such disputes and presents a way in which such disputes might be better adjudicated going forward.
